Frank Schmidt of Jefferson City State of Missouri the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and quitclaimed
unto the said Schmidt and to his heirs and assigns forever all
right title estate, interest claim and demands in possession
or in expectancy of me and to the following described land situated
in the Town of Lawrence, assuris. to wit: Lot Number Twenty
Eight (28) on New Jersey Street. To have and to hold the
afore described premises with the privileges and appurtenances
thereunto belonging, unto the said Schmidt his heirs and assigns
forever. And I the said David Upsham for myself and my heirs
executors and administrators, do covenant with the said Frank
Schmidt his heirs and assigns that the said premises are free
from all encumbrances made or suffered by me, that I have
full right and power to sell convey and quitclaim the same
and that I shall and will warrant and defend the same
unto the said Schmidt his heirs and assigns forever against all the
lawful claims and demands of all persons, claiming by whom

bound by these presents with the sum of Two hundred Dollars
