This Indenture Made this 29th day of January, in the Year of Our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and fifty Eight Between William B Walling of Lawrence Territory of Kansas of the first part and Samuel N Wood of the same place of the second part Witnesseth. That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Six hundred Dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth give grant, bargain sell release, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns, forever, all the following described lands, situate in Lawrence Douglas County Kansas Territory to wit Lots Numbered Eighty nine (89) and ninety one (91) Jennie Street in the Town of Lawrence said County and Territory, together with all lands singular the hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, both in law and Equity. - This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Six hundred Dollars secured by two promissory notes Even date herewith due one year after date for Three hundred Dollars, Each payable to said Wood or order - according to the conditions of 2 certain promissory notes this day Executed and delivered by the said William B Walling to the said party of the second part; and this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as herein specified. But if default be made in the payment of any part thereof as above provided then it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part his executors, administrators or assigns, at any time thereafter
