lying in the State of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas according
to the survey made by A. Seal A. D. 1854. to wit Lot (183)
One hundred and eighty three Kentucky Acres. And G. W.
and J. S. Brinson aforesaid our heirs, executors admiralty
and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in
the sum of Two hundred and fifty Dollars to pay Matilda
Bates aforesaid her heirs executors admiralty and assigns
to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title
to said land.
