Wright my heirs executors, and administrators are held and firmly bound by these presents, in the sum of Six Hundred Dollars to the said Nancy Hicks her heirs and assigns, to make and convey unto her or them, all further right or title which shall or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority, or by any person or persons by virtue of a title to the town site of Lawrence aforesaid, issuing from the General Land Office - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty fourth day of February A.
