and Quiesch parties of the secms part witnesseth, that in Consideration  
 with the premises contained in the Deed in Trust from me William  
 H. R. Syking, to the abv Trustees, creating said Trustees, and in  
 consideration of the sum of One Dollar or thereabouts paid by said Kimball  
 and Quiesch of this town and Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby  
 acknowledged, have conveyed, released and quit claimed, and by these  
 presents do convey, release and quit claim unto the said party of the  
 secms part, his heirs and assigns all right title and interest in and  
 to certain lots of land situated and being in Lawrence City Com'd  
 Trustees, Kansas Territory and designated on the Lithographed Chart  
 as surveyed by A. O. Seal October 4th 1854 as follows - Reserve  
 Number (2) according to the survey and plat made by A. O. Seal  
 To have and to hold the aforesaid quit claims, premises with all  
 the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said party  
 of the secms part so that neither we, said Trustees, our heirs  
 or successors, or any person claiming by or under us or them  
 shall have any right, title interest, claim or demands in or to  
 the aforesaid premises or any part thereof; and we hereby warrant  
 and agree to warrant and defend against all persons claiming  
 any right, title or interest under the said Trustees, their heirs or  
 successors. - An further this indenture witnesseth that the  
 said Samuel J. Snyder, Joel Smith, John Pitts, William  
 H. R. Syking and Geo. W. Hutchinson and their successors  
 are held and firmly bound unto the said Kimball and Quiesch  
 in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars, to be paid unto the said  
 Kimball and Quiesch their heirs or assigns, to which payment will  
 and truly to be made we bind ourselves and our successors by  
 these presents. Now the condition of this obligation is such that  
 if the payment by the said party of the secms part of all taxes  
 lawfully assessed upon the aforesaid premises, the said parties  
 of the first part to their successors, shall make and deliver  
 unto the said party of the secms part his heirs or assigns a good  
 and valid Deed with the usual Covenants for Conveyance  
 in fee simple whenever a patent for the town site of  
 Lawrence shall issue from Congress unto me  
"forward."
