


"Brought forward"

 presents, in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars, to the said E. Ladd
 his heirs and assigns; to make and convey unto him or them all
 further rights or title which I shall or may be awarded or
 conveyed to me by any authority, or by any person or persons by
 virtue of a title to the Town of Lawrence aforesaid quieting
