

Know all Men by these Presents That I,  
 Ira M Jones of the City of Lawrence Saint Paul of the  
 County of Ramsey and Territory of Minnesota am held  
 and firmly bound unto Joseph B Horne of the same  
 place in the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars  
 lawfull money of the United States, to be paid to the said  
 Joseph B Horne his heirs, Executors, administrators  
 and assigns, for which payment well and truly to be made  
 I do bind myself my heirs, Executors and assigns firmly  
 by these Presents, Whereas the said Ira M Jones has this  
 day bargained and sold unto the said Joseph B Horne his  
 heirs, Executors, administrators or assigns, those certain  
 pieces or parcels of land, situated lying, and being in the  
 County of \_\_\_\_\_ and Territory of Kansas designated and  
 described as follows, to wit - Lot numbered Seventeen (17) on  
 this Street, Lot number Twenty six (26) in New Jersey  
 Street, and Lot numbered Twenty four (24) in Massach-  
 usetts Street as designated in the plan or plat of certain lots  
 of land situated and lying in the Town of Lawrence, First  
 Precinct District Kansas Territory as shown on the Litho-  
 graphed Chart as surveyed by A D Earl in October <sup>as</sup> 1857.  
 And therefore the condition of the above obligation is such that  
 if the said Ira M Jones his Executors administrators or assigns  
 do upon the reasonable request, and within a reasonable time  
 after the Patent for the land, of which the foregoing described Lots  
 from a part shall have been issued from the Patent office  
 at Washington City, shall make execute and deliver to the said  
 Joseph B Horne his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns  
 a good and sufficient Warranty deed in fee simple from  
 all Encumbrances, except such as may arise by virtue of  
 any tax assessed subsequent to the twelfth day of December
