

Know all men by these Presents That I Turner Sampson of the Town of Lawrence Territory of Kansas for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Amos Bissell of Lawrence Kansas per the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and quit claimed and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim unto the said Amos Bissell his heirs, Executors, administrators, and assigns forever all my right title interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, & situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by C. A. Seal A.D. 1854. to wit. Lot Number Two Hundred and fifty five (255) on Indiana Street, and I Turner Sampson aforesaid my heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to said Amos Bissell aforesaid his heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from any power or person or persons whomever to any and all of the above described property To Have and To Hold the same, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging forever.
