

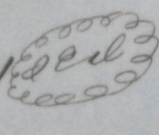

And I the said James A. Pinley my heirs and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Fifty dollars to the said John S Crane his heirs Executors and administrators to make and convey unto him or them all ^{the} ~~the~~ right or title which shall or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority, or by any person or persons by virtue of a title to the town site of Lawrence issuing from the General Land office. 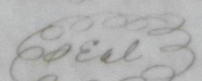
