

Know all Men by these Presents That I Lucius Kellogg of the Town of Lawrence Territory of Kansas for and in consideration of the sum of Thue hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Samuel Fry of the same place the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and quit claimed and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim unto the said Samuel Fry his heirs Executors, administrators, and assigns forever all my right title interest claim and demand in and to the following described land situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A D Searl A.D 1854, to wit: Lots One hundred & Nineteen (119) Rhode Island Street, and Thirty Seven (37) New Jersey Street - And I Lucius Kellogg aforesaid my heirs Executors administrators, and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Six Hundred Dollars to said Samuel Fry aforesaid his heirs Executors administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from any person or persons whomsoever to any and all of the above described property to have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging forever.
