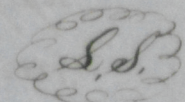
One Hundred and thirty nine (139) and Lot number one Hundred and thirty four (134) on Connecticut street.

S. Thompson his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by through or under me but against none other - and I the said S. B. Prentiss my heirs, Executors, and administrators, are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Six hundred Dollars to the said C. S. Thompson his heirs and assigns, to make and convey unto him or them all further right or title which shall or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority, or by any person or persons, by virtue of a title to the town site of Lawrence aforesaid issuing from the General Land office - In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this second day of April A. D. 1858.
