This Indenture made this third day of February AD 1858, between Samuel N Morris and Stephen J Willes, Lyman Allen and P A Bailey Trustees of the Lawrence Association, of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas parties of the first part and Ferdinand Fuller of the said town of Lawrence of the second part witnesseth that the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and in compliance with the provisions contained in a deed in trust from one William H. Relyea to the Trustees of the town site of Lawrence aforesaid creating said Trustees have Conveyed released and quit claimed and by these presents do convey release and quit claim unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns all right title and interest in and to certain lots of land situated and being in Lawrence First Census District Kansas Territory, and designated in the Lithographed Chart as surveyed by A D Seal October 1st 1854, as follows - Share Number One hundred and thirteen (113) containing the following lots, Pinckney Street twenty nine (29) - Kentucky Street Eighty nine (89) and One hundred twenty four (124) Louisiana Street Two hundred forty three (243) Pennsylvania Street - Thirty eight (38) New Jersey Street sixty eight (68) Indiana Street - Two hundred thirty seven (237) New Hampshire Street, One hundred eighty two (182) Delaware Street, One hundred thirteen (113) and One hundred fifteen (115) New Jersey Street, One hundred fifty four (154) and lot Pinckney Street one (1). To have and to hold the aforesaid quit claimed premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said party of the second part, so that neither we said Trustees nor heirs or successors to any person claiming by, from or under us or them, shall have any right title interest, claim or demand in or to the aforesaid premises or any part thereof; and we hereby warrant and agree to warrant and defend against all persons claiming any right title or interest
