



Know all men by these Presents That I Peter D. Ridener

in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by C. D. Seal et al.  
1854, lot: Lot No Thirty Seven (37) New Jersey Street. And Peter  
D. Ridener aforesaid my heirs Executors Administrators and assigns are  
held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Two hundred Dollars  
to the said Allen & Gilmore aforesaid thus thirs heirs Executors Administrators  
and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the  
title which I shall receive from the said Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence  
or from any person or persons or persons whosoever to any and all of the  
above described property to have and to hold the same with all the  
privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging forever - In witness

A.D. 1858.
