 to the following described land, situated in the town of Lawrence aforesaid  
 Court Lot No 18) One hundred and eighty seven Massachusetts  
 Street. To have and to hold the above described premises, with the  
 privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging unto the said C  
 Livingston & Wm Ritter their heirs and assigns forever, And I  
 the said W M Patterson for myself and my heirs Executors and  
 Administrators do covenant with the said C Livingston & Wm Ritter  
 their heirs and assigns that the said premises are free from all encum-  
 brances made or suffered by me that I have full right and power to  
 sell convey and quitclaim the same and that I shall and will  
 warrant and defend the same unto the said C Livingston &  
 Wm Ritter their heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims  
 and demands of all persons claiming by through or under me  
 but against none other And I the said W M Patterson his heirs  
 Executors and Administrators are held and firmly bound by these  
 presents in the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to the said C Livingston  
 & Wm Ritter their heirs and assigns to make and convey unto him  
 them all just his right title which shall or may be awarded or  
 conveyed to him by any authority, or by any person or persons by virtue  
 of a title to the said site of Lawrence aforesaid issuing from the
