administrators and assigns are held  
and firmly bound by these presents in  
the sum of two thousand Dollars to the  
said Rufus S. Bassett his heirs, Executors  
administrators and assigns, to well and  
truly make over and convey unto him  
or them a good and valid title such  
as the said George N. Hunt shall receive  
from the trustees of the City of Lawrence  
to any and all of the above described  
lot have and to hold the same with all  
the privileges and appurtenances therunto
