 of the sum of Four Hundred Dollars to me
 in hand paid by Rufus S. Bassett of the Town
 and Territory aforesaid, the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged have bargained sold
 and quit claimed and by these presents do
 bargain sell and quit claim unto the said
 Rufus S. Bassett his heirs Executors admini-
 strators and assigns, forever, all my
 right, title interest claim and demand
 in and to the following described land
 situate and lying in the City of Lawrence
 in the Territory of Kansas, to wit: Lot Number
 Seventy Eight (78) on Belmont Street in the
 City aforesaid and I the said James Christian,
 my heirs, Executors administrators and
 are held and firmly bound by these presents
 in the sum of Eight Hundred Dollars to
 the said Rufus S. Bassett his heirs Executors
 administrators and assigns to well and truly
 pay and deliver
