

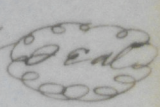
"Brought Forward"

in the sum of One hundred Dollars to
the said Rahm his heirs and assigns to
make and convey unto him or them, all
further right or title which shall or may
be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority
or by any person or persons by virtue of a title
to the town site of Lawrence aforesaid issuing
from the General Land office. In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
seal this sixth day of April A.D. 1858.

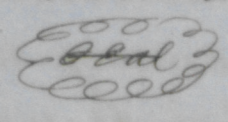
