Sykins aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them a good and valid title when I shall receive the same from the trustees of the Town site of Lawrence, or any other person or persons to any and all of the above described property to have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging forever.
