 said Starks & Guest, and all other property belonging
 to said Mills or mills which was owned by the firm
 of Starks & Guest except what is reserved by special
 agreement between the said Starks & Guest. In these
 articles of dissolution of partnership this day made
 and signed by said Starks & Guest, to which articles
 reference is had for a description of the property herein
 reserved from mortgage also in consideration of
 One dollar as aforesaid we hereby grant bargain
 sell & mortgage to the said Starks his heirs assigns
 all our right title and interest in the mill
 lot above described, the said premises & the
 said personal property being the same all right
 title & interest in which the said Starks
 has this day conveyed to us. Provided that
 if we the said Franklin Frederic Samuel
 & Edward Kimball, or either of us shall well
 and truly pay to the said Starks or his assigns
 the sum of Forty five hundred Dollars & twelve
 per cent int' according to the tenor of your
 several promissory notes which we have
 this day signed & given to said Starks, the
 first note being for the sum of two hundred
 Dollars, payable to said Starks thirty days
 from date. the second note being for the sum
 "Forward"
