security of said mortgage, and whereas

solved partnership leaving unpaid certain
claims and demands due from the firm of
Starks & Guest for labor & materials furnished
& expended on said mill on the property
conveyed to said Franklin Frederic Samuel
and Edward Kimball by the deed herein
