

"Brought Forward"

Kimball and the said Guest or Either of them shall pay to said Starks or his heirs assigns, Executors or administrators, the said sum of Forty five hundred Dollars, according to the tenor of said promissory notes, provided the said property shall suffer loss by fire or accident whereby the security of said deed of mortgage shall be impaired or if said Franklin Frederic Samuel and Edward Kimball and the said Guest or Either of them upon the request of said Starks his assigns Executors or administrators shall make the security for the payment of said promissory notes, as good and ample as it now is in case of such loss as aforesaid and if the said Franklin Frederic Samuel and Edward Kimball and the said Guest shall become responsible for the claims & demands due from the firm of Starks & Guest, as aforesaid in a sum not exceeding two thousand Dollars & shall save harmless this said Starks his administrators & Executors from all such claims and demands not exceeding the said amount of two thousand Dollars then this obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue
