Wood William H. Sykinis and Geo. Hutchinson and their successors are held and firmly bound ^{unto} by these the ^{in the sum of five thousand dollars to be paid unto the said Nathan Starks} said Nathan Starks, his heirs or assigns to which payments well and truly to be made we bind ourselves and our successors by these presents. Now the condition of this obligation is such that if upon the payment by the said party of the second part of all taxes lawfully assessed upon the aforesaid premises. the said parties of the first part, or their successors shall make and deliver unto the said party of the second his heirs or assigns, a good and valid Deed, with the usual covenants for conveyance in fee simple.
