Hundred and Seventy Six Ohio St. and Lot
Number Forty one (41) Pinkney St. And the
said J. M. Winchell my heirs executors adm-
inistrators and assigns are held and firmly
bound by these presents in the sum of One
Thousand Dollars to the said Sanford W.
Voglesong his executors administrators and
assigns well and truly make over and convey
to him or them a good and valid title
such as the said J. M. Winchell shall receive
from the Trustees of the City of Lawrence to any
and all of the above described property to have and
to hold the same with all the privileges and
appurtenances therunto belonging forever. In
