such payment be made as herein specified.
But if default be made in the payment of any
part thereof as above provided, then it shall
be lawful for the said party of the second part
his Executors, Administrators or assigns, at any time
hereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or
any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law;
and out of all the money arising from such
sale, to retain the amount then due for principal
and interest with the costs and charges of making
such sale, and the attorney's fees for conveyance and
the surplus if any there be shall be paid by the party
making such sale on demand to the said Perry L.
Teter his heirs or assigns In Witness Whereof the
party of the first part has hereunto set his hand.
