the said Richard G. Wait his heirs and assigns forever, and
I the said George H. Hunt for myself and my heirs
Executors and administrators, do warrant unto the
said Richard G. Wait his heirs and assigns that the
said premises oufru from all Encumbrances made
or suffered by me, that I have full right and power to
to sell convey and quit claim the same and that I shall
and will warrant and defend the same unto the
said Richard G. Wait his heirs and assigns forever against
the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming
by through or under me but against none other, and
I the said George H. Hunt my heirs Executors and
administrators are held and firmly bound by
these presents in the sum of Seven hundred Dollars
to the said Richard G. Wait his heirs and assigns
to make and convey unto him or them all further
right or title which shall or may be awarded or con-
veyed to me by any authority, or by any person or persons
by virtue of a title to the Town site of Lawrence aforsaid
issuing from the General Land Office.
