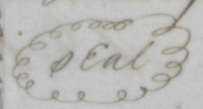

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth give grant grant
bargain sell release and convey and confirm unto the said party
of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever, all the
following described land situated in the County of Douglas
Kansas Territory to wit: The south west quarter of the north west
quarter of section Eight in township thirteen of Range twenty - also
Lots Number twenty two twenty four twenty six Kentucky Street
with the buildings thereon, also Lots One hundred and ninety six
