are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Two
Hundred Dollars, to the said Casper Wreck his heirs and assigns
to make and convey unto him or them all the further title which
shall or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority, or
by my heirs or assigns by virtue of a title to the town site of Lawrence
aforesaid issuing from the General Land office. In witness
