Lowry of the same place the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and quitclaimed and by these presents do bargain sell and quitclaim unto the said Cyrus H. Lowry his heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns forever all my right title interest claim and demand in and to the following described land situated and lying in the City of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas to wit: Lot Number sixty six (66.) in Kentucky Street in the City of Lawrence according to the survey made by A. D. Earle in October A.D. 1854.

And I John A. Lowry aforesaid my heirs, Executors administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Eight Hundred Dollars to said Cyrus H. Lowry aforesaid his heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns to act and truly make over and convey unto him or them a good and valid title to any further interest that I may acquire in or to said piece of land from any person or persons whatsoever to any and all of the above described property to have and to hold the same, with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging forever.
