

Know all Men by these Presents That I, Samuel Fry of the City of Lawrence Territory of Kansas for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Dollars to me in hand paid by Thomas Fry of the City of Brooklyn and State of New York the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and quit claimed and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim unto the said Thomas Fry and to his heirs and assigns from all my right, title Estate, interest, claim and demand in possession or in expectancy of me and to the following described, Situated in the City of Lawrence aforesaid, to wit: The south half of lot number (37) Thirtynine on New Hampshire Street, lots number (154) One hundred and fifty four and one hundred and fifty six (156) on Louisiana Street; lots number (106) One hundred and six, and (126) One hundred and twenty six on Maryland Street and "Grand"
