This Indenture, made this third day of March A.D. 1858, between Samuel A. Wood, Joel Gray, Stephen J. Willis, Lyman Allen, and J. A. Bailey, Trustees of the Lawrence Association, of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas, parties of the first part, and Ferdinand Fuller, of the said Town of Lawrence, of the second part, Witnesseth.

That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and in compliance with the provisions contained in a deed in trust from one William H. R. Cykins to the Trustees of the Town of Lawrence aforesaid, creating said trustees have conveyed released and quit claimed, and by these presents do convey, release and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all right, title and interest in and to certain lots of land, situated and being in Lawrence, First Council District, Kansas Territory, and designated on the Lithographed Chart, as surveyed by A. D. Earl, October A.D. 1854, as follows:
