 and demand in possession or in expectancy
 of no and to the following described land
 situated in the City of Lawrence aforesaid
 to wit: The south half of Lot sixteen New
 Hampshire Street to have and to hold the
 above described premises, with the privileges and
 appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said
 A J Blanchard his heirs and assigns forever.
 And I the said T. Yunker for myself and
 my heirs, executors and administrators
 do covenant with the said A J Blanchard
 his heirs and assigns, that the said premises
 are free from all encumbrances made or suffered
 by me; that I have full right and power to sell
 convey and quit claim the same, and that
 I shall and will warrant and defend the
 same unto the said A J Blanchard his heirs
 and assigns forever against the lawful claims
 and demands of all persons, claiming by
 through or under me but against none other.
 And I the said T. Yunker my heirs executors
 and administrators are held and firmly bound
 by these presents in the sum of One thousand
 dollars to said A J Blanchard his heirs
 and assigns to make and convey unto him
