power to sell <sup>my and quit claim</sup> the same and that I shall and  
will warrant and defend the same unto  
the said Oldham her heirs and assigns forever  
against the lawful claims and demands of all  
persons claiming by through or under me but  
against none other. And I the said Edward  
Winslow my heirs, Executors, and administrators  
are held and firmly bound by these presents  
in the sum of Four Hundred Dollars to  
said Eunice A Oldham her heirs and assigns  
to make and convey unto her or them all  
further right or title which shall or may be  
awarded or conveyed unto her or them by  
any authority or by any person or persons  
by virtue of a title to the town site of Lawrence  
aforesaid arising from the General Land office -
