of the sum of Five hundred Dollars in hand
paid by John C. Gould of same place the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and confessed
have bargained sold and quit claimed and by these presents
do grant bargain and quit claim unto the said John C.
Gould his heirs and assigns forever all my right title
and interest in the following described land lying and
being in the City of Leavenworth County of Douglas and
Territory of Kansas To wit: Lot Number forty two (42)
on Louisiana Street Lot Number two hundred and
fifty nine (259) Indiana Street Lot Number fifty
(50) Vermont Street according to survey made
by A. D. Seal A. D. 1854. And I Rufus Hall
aforesaid my heirs and administrators are held and
firmly bound by by these presents in the sum of One
thousand Dollars to John C. Gould aforesaid his
heirs and assigns to well and truly make and
convey to him or them all the title which I may
or shall receive from the Trustees of the said City
"Leavenworth"
