D. Seal A. D. 1854. And I Harry R. Brooks aforesaid my heirs assigns and administrators am held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Fifteen hundred Dollars (\$1500) to the said John E. Gould aforesaid his heirs and assigns, to well and truly to make and convey to him or them all the title which I may or shall receive from the Trustees of the said City of Lawrence or from any ^{person} person or persons, to any and all of the above described property to have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging forever.
