these presents do bargain sell and quit claim unto
the said Crane and to his heirs and assigns
Forever all my right, title Estate, interest, claim
and demand in possession or in Expectancy
of in and to the following described land
Situate and lying in the City of Lawrence aforesaid
to wit: Lot Number One Hundred twenty-
four (124) on Tennessee Street. To Have and
to Hold the same above described premises with
the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging
unto the said Crane, his heirs and assigns
Forever. And I the said Lyman for myself
and my heirs Executors and administrators do

that the said premises are free from all
Encumbrances made or suffered by me; that
I have full right and power to sell convey and quit claim
