Matt his heirs and assigns that the said premises are free from all Encumbrance made or suffered by me; that I have full right and power to sell convey and quitclaim the same and that I shall and will Warrant and Defend the same unto the said C. W. Southmayd my heirs Executors and administrators as child and family bound by these presents in the sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred ^{saunders} Dollars to the said John S. Matt his heirs and assigns. To make and convey unto him or them all further right or title which shall or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority or by any person or persons by virtue of a title to the town site of Saurice aforesaid issuing from the General Land Office.
