and that I shall and will warrant and
Defend the same unto the said John Day
Frances Allen her heirs and assigns forever
against the lawful claims and demands
of all persons claiming by, through or under
me but against none other. And I the said
John Day my heirs, Executors and administrators
are held and firmly bound by this present instrument
the sum of Two Hundred Dollars, to the said
Frances Allen her heirs and assigns to
make and carry unto her or them all
full the right or title which shall or may
be awarded or conveyed to me by any
authority or by any person or persons by
virtue of a title to the town site of Launcelot
aforesaid issuing from the General Land
Office In U.S. Where I have caused to be
my hands and seal the twenty second day
of June A.D. 1808.
