This Indenture, Made this 21st day
 of June in the year of Our Lord "One
 thousand Eight hundred and fifty 8
 Between James A. Winley, and E. A. Winley
 his wife of Launee & County of Douglas K.T.
 of the first part and George Warren of the
 County and Territory aforesaid of the second
 part Witnesseth, the said party of the first
 for and in consideration of the sum of Five
 hundred Dollars (\$500.00) the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth give
 grant bargain, sell release, convey and confirm
 unto the said party of the second part and
 to his heirs and assigns, forever, all the
 following described land situated in the town
 of Launee & Kansas Territory, to wit:
 Lot Number Eight Massachusetts as described
 upon the plat of said town. together with
 all and singular the hereditaments thereto
 belonging, or in any wise appertaining both
 in law and Equity. This Grant is intended
 as a Mortgage, to secure the payment of the
 sum of Five Hundred Dollars, according
 to the conditions of a certain promissory Note
 Executed and delivered the Eight day of June
 1858, by the said James A. Winley to the
 said party of the second; and this conveyance
 shall be void if such payment be made
 as herein specified. But if default be made
 in the payment of any part thereof, as here
 provided, then it shall be lawful for the
 said party of the second part his Executors
 administrators or assigns at any time thereafter
 to sell the premises hereby granted, or any
 part thereof, in the manner prescribed by
 the laws of the Territory of Kansas.
