

"Brought forward above described premises, with the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the said G. W. Branson, his heirs and assigns forever. And I the said Clark Davidson for myself and my heirs, Executors, and administrators do covenant with the said G. W. Branson his heirs and assigns that the said premises are free from all encumbrances made or suffered by me; that I have full right and power to sell convey and quit claims the same and that I shall and will warrant and defend the same unto the said G. W. Branson. His heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons, claiming by, through or under me but against none other. And I the said Clark Davidson my heirs Executors and administrators are bound and bindly bound by this present in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to the said G. W. Branson his heirs and assigns, to make and convey unto him or them all further right or title which shall or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any person or persons, by virtue of a title to the town site of Fairview aforesaid issuing from the General Land Office.
