 myself my heirs, Executors and administrators
 firmly by these presents sealed with my seal
 Dated this Eighth day of May One thousand
 Eight hundred and fifty Eight. The condition
 of the above obligation is such that whereas the
 above bounden Henry Hart has this day by
 agreement sold and quit claimed to the said
 Hendersons the north half of lot number twenty
 six (26.) Rhode Island Street in said Town
 of Lawrence, upon which the said Henderson
 has paid Fifty Dollars (\$50.) the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged; and whereas
 the said Hendersons has Executed to the said
 Hart a promissory note of Even date herewith
 for One hundred & Fifty Dollars due in one
 year from the date hereof, now if the said
 Hart his heirs Executors or administrators
 upon the payment of the said note at maturity
 shall Execute and deliver to the said Hendersons
 his heirs or assigns a good and valid deed
 of Warranty of quit claims as the case may be
 of the above described property; then the above
 obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in
 full force and virtue
