



Know all men by these presents That

 aforesaid. And C.H. Babcock & T.H.R. Lykins aforesaid
 their heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns, are held
 and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Four
 Thousand Dollars to said George W. Crocker aforesaid
 his heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns to well
 and truly make over and convey unto him or them a
 good and valid title such as they shall receive from the
 Trustees of the City of Lawrence to any and all of the above
 described property to have and hold the same with all
 the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging forever
