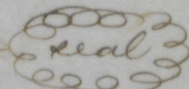

(110) Delaware Street, and I John W. Parks aforesaid my
heirs Executors, administrators and assigns are held and
firmly bound by these presents, to well and truly convey unto
him or them a good and valid title, such I shall receive
from the trustees of the town of Lawrence to have and to
