

Know all Men by these Presents That we Wesley H. Duncan and Charles S. Duncan, partners of the name and firm of H & C. Duncan of the City of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas aforesaid and firmly bound ~~between~~ unto Ingle Barker of Lawrence aforesaid in the sum of Eight thousand Dollars lawful money of the United States, to be paid to the said Ingle Barker his Executors, Administrators or assigns; for which payment well and truly to be paid we bind ourselves our heirs, Executors and Administrators, firmly by these presents - Sealed with our seals dated this seventeenth day of July A.D. 1858. One thousand eight hundred and fifty eight - The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden H & C. Duncan their heirs, Executors, Administrators shall and truly make, Execute and deliver to the said Ingle Barker his heirs or assigns, a good and sufficient deed, with the usual covenants of the south half of lot Number Thirty (30.) on Massachusetts Street in said Lawrence, w<sup>m</sup> before the 15<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1858. and upon the Execution and delivery by the said Ingle Barker to the said H & C. Duncans of three several promissory Notes as follows, to wit: One for Five Hundred and Twenty Dollars payable March 1<sup>st</sup> 1859. One for Five Hundred Dollars payable October 15<sup>th</sup> 1859. and one for Five hundred Dollars payable October 15<sup>th</sup> 1860. (By "deed with the usual covenants" is meant a deed of warranty and quit claim as the said Duncans may hold said premises at the time specified, by virtue of the one or the other) then the above obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
