To five trustees in trust for the use and benefit of the religious society now worshipping in said building to the terms of agreement between said association and said society: and also to demand & receive from the said trustees all & singular the deeds of Mortgage, bonds, promissory Notes or other securities & assurances necessary & proper to secure to the said Association the payment of all and singular the sums of money, both principal and interest to be secured and to the said Association by the aforesaid agreement; and all things on behalf of said Association concerning the sale and Conveyance of the said lands and buildings according to the terms of said agreement, but not otherwise.
