Know all Men by these Presents That I Thomas  
 Gray of City of Brooklyn State of New York Esq and  
 in Consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars  
 to me in hand paid by Johnathan Allen Jr of the City  
 of Lawrence Kansas Territory the receipt whereof is  
 hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and quit claimed  
 and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim  
 unto the said Johnathan Allen, and to his heirs and  
 assigns forever all my right title, Estate, interest, claim  
 and demand in possession of my Effectancy of, in and  
 to the following described land, situated in the City of  
 Lawrence aforesaid to wit: Lot Number Eighty five  
 (85.) on Delaware Street To have and to hold to the  
 above described premises with the privilege and appurtenances  
 thereunto belonging unto the said Allen his heirs and  
 assigns forever. And I the said Gray, for myself and  
 my heirs, Executors and administrators do moreover saith  
 the said Allen his heirs and assigns that the said  
 premises are free from all Encumbrances made or  
 suffered by me; that I have full right and power  
 to sell convey and quit claim the same and that I  
 shall and will warrant and defend the same unto  
 the said Allen his heirs and assigns forever, against  
 the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming  
 by through or under me but against none other. And I the  
 said Thomas Gray my heirs, Executors and administrators  
 am held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of  
 Two hundred Dollars to the said Johnathan Allen his  
 heirs and assigns, to make and convey unto him or them  
 all further right or title which shall or may be awarded  
 or conveyed to me by any authority or by any person or  
 persons by virtue of a title to the town site Lawrence  
 aforesaid issuing from the General Land Office  
 In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
 and seal this twenty fourth day of July A.D. 1858.
