D. Seab A. D. 1854. to wit: Lot No One hundred & fifty eight (158) on Kentucky Street. And I John Bowles aforesaid my heirs Executors administrators and assigns in full and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to H. R. Brooks aforesaid his heirs, ^{Executors administrators} and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any person or persons whomsoever to any and all of the above described property To Have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto ^{thereunto} belonging forever.
