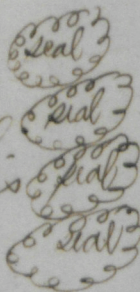


"Brought forward"

made, we bind ourselves and our successors
by these presents. Now the Condition of the above
obligation is such that if upon the payment
by the said party of the second part of all lawful
taxes lawfully assessed upon the aforesaid premises
the said parties of the first part, or their successors
shall make and deliver unto the said party of the
second part, his heirs or assigns, a good and valid
Deed, with the usual covenants for conveyances in fee
simple, whenever a Patent for the Town Site of Lawrence
shall issue from Congress unto one Robert Robitaille, or
William H. R. Lykins, and be conveyed unto the
aforesaid Trustees then this obligation shall be void and
of no Effect otherwise to remain in full force, In Testimony

4th day of August A. D. 1858.
