 Territory of the first part and George Ford
 of the same place of the second part Witnesseth
 That the said parties of the first part, for and
 in consideration of the sum of Five hundred
 Dollars the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 doth give grant, bargain sell, release convey and
 confirm unto the said party of the second
 part, and to his heirs and assigns
 forever, all the following described land
 situated in Lawrence Douglas County Kansas
 Territory, to wit Lot Number Twenty one (21)
 Rhode Island Street according to the
 survey made by A. D. Searle together with all
 and singular the hereditaments and appurtenan-
 ces thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining
 both in law and Equity This Grant is Intended
 as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum
 of Five hundred Dollars with interest at the
 rate of Twenty four per Cent per annum until
 paid & due in twelve months from the date of
 these presents according to the conditions of a
 Certain promissory Note this day Executed and delivered
 by the said Ezekiel A. Coleman to the said party
 of the second part; and this conveyance shall
 be void if such payment be made as herein
 specified. But if default be made in payment or
 any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law
 and out of all the moneys arising from such
 sale, to retain the amount then due for principal
 and interest together with the Costs and Charges
 "forward"
