To have and to hold the above described premises with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto the said Harriet and to her heirs and assigns forever. And I the said Joseph J. Hollins for myself and my heirs, Executors and administrators, do covenant with the said Harriet her heirs and assigns, that the said premises are free from all Encumbrances made or suffered by me; that I have full right and power to sell convey and quit claim the same, and that I shall and will warrant and defend the same, and that I shall and will warrant and defend unto the said Harriet her heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by through or under me but against none other - And I the said Hollins my heirs, Executors and administrators are held and firmly bound by these
