any wise pertaining. To have and to hold all and
singular, the above mentioned and described lot or
parcel of land, situate lying and being as aforesaid
together with all and singular the houses, woods, waters,
ways and privileges thereto belonging, or in any wise
appertaining unto them the said John M. Graham, Charles
S. Duncan, Francis Killam, Henry Wheaton, Silas
Green, Edward A. Barnes, and George W. Berry and
their successors in office forever in trust, that they
shall erect and build, or cause to be erected and built
thereon a house or place of worship for the use of the Methodist
Episcopal Church in the United States of America in the
Town of Lawrence, and for the members belonging to said
Methodist Episcopal Church or society of the same in
the Town of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas, according
to the rules and discipline which from time to time may
be agreed upon and adopted by the Ministers and preachers
of the said Church at their General Conference in the
United States of America; and in further trust and
confidence that they shall at all times, forever and
hereafter permit such Ministers and preachers belonging
to the said Church, as shall from time to time be
duly authorized by the General Conferences of the United
Ministers and preachers of the said Methodist Episcopal
Church or by the Annual Conferences authorized by the said
